Third Sunday of Lent — Year A 15 March 2020

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

My eyes are always on the Lord, for he releases my feet from the snare. Turn to me and have mercy on me, for I am alone and poor.

FIRST READING: EXODUS 17:3-7 Give us water to drink.

RESPONSORIAL PS: Ps 94:1-2.6-9

SECOND READING: ROMANS 5:1-2. 5-8

The love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us.

If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Glory to you, Word of God, Lord Jesus Christ! Lord, you are truly the Saviour of the world; give me living water, that I may never thirst again. Glory to you, Word of God, Lord Jesus Christ!

GOSPEL: JOHN 4:5-42

The water that I shall give will turn into a spring of eternal life.

COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

For anyone who drinks it, says the Lord, the water I shall give will become in him a spring welling up to eternal life.

REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

The number of rules and conventions Jesus destroys in this Gospel text are almost too numerable to count. Throwing caution to the wind he sits with a Samaritan woman. Students of the Old Testament know what happens between women and men at wells. Now, of course, Jesus isn't going to marry her, but a bond of truthfulness is formed. She grows to know him for who he is. Her self-hatred, doubts, and rigid rules are washed away in the flowing water of love. Do we allow the same thing to happen with us? Today is the first Scrutiny for those preparing to receive the initiation sacraments at the Easter Vigil. The elect are called to discern in their life what needs to be washed away.

Gospel Reflection...

The first of three stories from John about baptism, preparing us for the renewal of baptismal promises at Easter. Baptism is the well where we establish a relationship with Jesus as Friend, Saviour and Priest. He is Friend to a woman who is thirsty, lonely, shattered by broken relationships, misled by religious controversy. He is a Saviour to whom all sins are known, yet he longs to impart forgiveness. He is a Priest who leads us in true worship, in spirit and in truth. He is the Truth and he has released the Spirit. True worship is glorifying the Father, through the Son in the uniting power of the Holy Spirit. Lent is a time to develop our relationship with the divine Friend, Saviour and Priest.

'Tormented by thirst' (Exodus). The torment of today is in thirst for meaning, for a reason to live, moral direction, stability, an answer to suffering, etc.. The woman at the well found the answer to her thirst for understanding, her need for forgiveness, her desire for stability in relationship, her instruction in true worship. If we only appreciated all that God offers us in Jesus! And in the gift of the Spirit there is an inner fountain with eternal answers. The love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given to us. (Second reading).

Study The Catechism of the Catholic Church, #2560. 'The wonder of prayer is revealed beside the well where we come seeking water: there, Christ comes to meet every human being. It is he who first seeks us and asks us for a drink. Jesus thirsts his asking arises from the depths of God's desire for us ... Prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts for us that we may thirst for him.' Prayer is meeting with Jesus who wants us to sit down beside him. All he asks for is an empty bucket ... empty time and a bit of space in our thoughts. Then he will do the rest. If we only knew what God is offering!
