REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

Most of us cannot imagine blindness. We've always been able to see. Spiritual blindness, however, is more common. For example, we look back in history and can't imagine how people could own slaves and still consider themselves good Christians. Blindness still exists and we need to hear the this reading often. The Pharisee's blindness is called out by Jesus. What about our own? Do we judge others and not see our sinfulness? What about our prejudices? Do we hide behind language such as "hate the sin but love the sinner"? We need to be careful of our attitudes. Lets start today with our blindness. Where do we not see our evil? Do we have the courage to ask another to help us see?

The Diocese of Parramatta has published a summary of these guidelines is as follows:

From the Fourth Sunday of Lent (Sunday 22nd March 2020), Catholics in the Diocese of Parramatta are dispensed from their Sunday Mass obligations until further notice (Canon 1248 §2 and Catechism 2181) For parishes that will still hold Masses, the following is to be noted: Parishes where 100 people or less attend Mass: they may continue to hold Masses in the church building Parishes where Mass attracts more than 100 people: if a parish chooses to hold the Mass, it must be held outdoors. This should be celebrated without music, people should endeavour to maintain social distance and the Mass should where possible not exceed 40 minutes Parishes are asked to assess their own local situation and make appropriate judgement as to whether they should continue with the Sunday celebrations Parish offices: should be kept open as much as feasible The full guidelines can be found here: parracatholic.org/covid19

The Parish of Richmond will continue to celebrate all masses at this weekend in the precincts of St. Monica's Primary school, St. John of God and St. Gregory's. However this decision will be reviewed early next week and will be published on our parish website/Facebook.

- The sick, the elderly and the vulnerable are advised to remain at home. You may watch the mass on the television on Channel 10 at 6 am or explore other social media like Youtube.
- The second Rite of Reconciliation on 6 March stands cancelled. Individual confessions are still available.
- The church at St. Monica's will be open for private visit and prayer during the day.
- Baptisms of infants should proceed with only the parents and Godparents.
- Marriages, if they proceed, as a suggestion should be attended by the bridal party and immediate family.
- In the case of funerals, it is suggested that only immediate family members should attend.

Gospel Reflection...

The Blind Man is the second story from John about our baptismal relationship with Christ. I am the light of the world.

Paul, second reading, offers ideas about baptism as the sacrament of light. Be like children of light, for the effects of light are seen in complete goodness, to right living and truth. Are we committed to complete goodness, to right living and to truth in all things? What does the Lord want of us? What are the futile works of darkness? Are people any longer ashamed of sinful deeds? Would I do things differently under the eye of a security camera? The eye of God sees even more than the camera, even our secret motives and intentions. Lent is a call to wake up, to leave the past behind and walk in the light of Christ.


