

REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

John 3:16. How many times have we seen the sign displaying this passage behind home plate or in the end zone of a football game? We need to give credit to these creative evangelizers. Proclaiming

the Gospel is about these small, yet significant moments. It's just a sign, but people find it intriguing. Each of us should consider how we evangelize. It's not just about going house to house. It can be as simple as a Nativity display on our lawn at Christmas, ashes on our head on Ash Wednesday, or the bumper stickers or magnets on our cars. But more importantly, it's how we live. Our coworkers will notice whether we handle death or illness with faith. Our lives are always witnesses to our love and belief in God.

Gospel Reflection...

1. The love of God the Father

This is the beginning of all life. Love comes from God and anyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God. (1 John 4:7) Why did God create people in his own image and likeness? Love did not permit God to remain alone. (Aquinas) God wished to have co-lovers. (Scotus). The first reading proclaims Lord, Lord, a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness. It's people who have neve actually read the Bible who say that the Old Testament is all about war and cruelty! Divine revelation is the story of a God of love and compassion.

2. The grace of Jesus Christ

God loved the world so much that, even after sin, he sent his Son. Not to condemn but to take away sin and its consequences ... and to offer the fullness of life. The grace ... that is, the favour ... or the gift of the Father is manifested especially in the coming of the Son in human flesh. He came down to the human level of life in order to lift us up into sharing in divine life.

3. The fellowship of the Holy Spirit

This is the bond of divine love uniting us with the Father and with one another. Love begins in the Father; is manifested to us in the Son; and poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. The power to live as children of God in love is available to us because of the presence of the Holy Spirit ... an inner spring welling up to eternal life.

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

Due to the easing of restrictions announced most recently by the NSW Government, from 1 June 2020, St. Monica's Church Richmond will be able to accommodate 50 worshippers for Masses and 20 people at St. Gregory's, Kurrajong.

- To attend WEEKDAY masses at St. Monica's, one need not register beforehand. However, you need to fill in your details on the sheet provided at the side entrance (near the office).
- To participate at WEEKEND MASSES, please click on the REGISTRATION FOR MASSES, then click on the date of the Mass that you wish to register for and fill in the details on the Google form, and remember to click the Submit button. Please note, one registration for one individual only. eg. A family of eight fills in eight registration forms.
- To allow as many parishioners to attend, please register for just one weekend Mass not multiple. Decide which Mass you and/or the family will attend and register ONLY for that Mass.
- Note that the parish office will not accept bookings via the phone or email or oral messages anymore. If internet is not accessible, do request a family or friend to help you in this regard. If you know someone who does not have access to the internet please reach out to them and assist them to register.
- To facilitate more participation, extra masses have been organised for the weekends. The duration of masses will be around 30 minutes. This will allow time for sanitising each space before the next group of parishioners enters the Church.
- A register of attendees for contact tracing will be at the entrance. Please sign against your name and provide your contact details. This is a legal requirement.

- · Remember to maintain physical and safe distancing and personal hygiene.
- Enjoy Mass. Remember, Communion in the hand only, not on the tongue.
- Please be mindful and refrain from any kind of socialising outside the church thus allowing car parking spaces for the next mass.
- We ask that parishioners not attend Mass if you are feeling unwell, even if you have reserved your attendance for the Mass.
- Rosters distributed at the beginning of the Church year will resume as from next weekend. For the additional Masses, ministers


