REFLECTIONS ON THE READING... The gift of the Eucharist. As we approach the Eucharist Sunday after Sunday we are different each time. Sometimes we are attentive. Other times, distracted. We see the little one with hands barley

large enough to hold a host. We see arthritic ones, stumbling toward the

Lord. The world over we come to share in the feast. Saints and sinners, we come, beckoned by the Lord. There are many images, theologies, thoughts, and reflection on the Body and Blood of the Lord. Which is your favourite? Which challenges you? As the bread and wine are transformed into the Real Presence of the Lord, may we too be changed this day.

Gospel Reflection...

The memory of his passion is recalled. At Eucharist, we remember the death, resurrection and ascension of the Lord. To remember, in the biblical sense, is to believe that the presence and power of God as shown in the past event are similarity present in this celebration. 'The Paschal mystery of Christ is celebrated, not repeated. It is the celebrations that are repeated, and in each celebration there is an outpouring of the Holy Spirit that makes the unique mystery present.' (Catechism, #1104)

The soul is filled with grace. Bread is a sign of feeding, strengthening. Sharing food means sharing the support of life, hence Paul's saying, one bread, one body. Companionship comes from cum-panis, sharing bread. Holy Communion differs from ordinary food, which becomes part of us ... our blood, our fat, our muscles. In the Eucharist we become what we receive, more Christlike in thinking and behaving, stronger in Christian values.

Our future glory is quaranteed by the living bread come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world. Every Mass celebrates Christ will come again. At the time of the Exodus the manna from heaven was their food for the journey until they reached the promised land. The manna foreshadowed the real bread from heaven, Jesus himself given to us in the Eucharist, as the food to sustain us on the journey to heaven.



DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

Due to the easing of restrictions announced most recently by the NSW Government, from 1 June 2020, St. Monica's Church Richmond will be able to accommodate 50 worshippers for Masses and 20 people at St. Gregory's, Kurrajong.

- To attend WEEKDAY masses at St. Monica's, one need not register beforehand. However, you need to fill in your details on the sheet provided at the side entrance (near the office).
- To participate at WEEKEND MASSES, please click on the REGISTRATION FOR MASSES, then click on the date of the Mass that you wish to register for and fill in the details on the Google form, and remember to click the Submit button. Please note, one registration for one individual only. eg. A family of eight fills in eight registration forms.
- To allow as many parishioners to attend, please register for just one weekend Mass not multiple. Decide which Mass you and/or the family will attend and register ONLY for that Mass.
- Note that the parish office will not accept bookings via the phone or email or oral messages anymore. If internet is not accessible, do request a family or friend to help you in this regard. If you know someone who does not have access to the internet please reach out to them and assist them to register.
- To facilitate more participation, extra masses have been organised for the weekends. The duration of masses will be around 30 minutes. This will allow time for sanitising each space before the next group of parishioners enters the Church.
- A register of attendees for contact tracing will be at the entrance. Please sign against your name and provide your contact details. This is a legal requirement.
