## REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

Like Peter we too have often set out confidently across the waters of life. However, as soon as the winds of trouble rise against us, and the waves of adversity begin to buffet us, we lose our nerve and begin to sink. Lord, when our faith falters, as

it often does, may we hear your gentle voice saying to us, 'Courage! Do not be afraid.' In that moment, Lord, may your divine power uphold us, calm our fears, steady our nerves, and enable us to steer our little boat to a place of safety and peace, beyond the wind and the waves.

## **Gospel Reflection...**

The story of the boat in the storm anticipates the time of the church. Jesus had gone up the mountain to pray ...anticipating the time after his ascension. Peter skippers the boat. The storms today are obvious. But 'God is watching us', even if it is 'from a distance'. The response to the psalm is appropriate. Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help.

When you walk through a storm hold your head up high ... as long as Peter looked toward the Lord he could walk on water. But when he focused on the heaving sea he began to sink. 'Let us not lose sight of Jesus, who leads us in our faith and brings it to perfection.' (Heb 12:2) Focus on the bad news and the heaving storms and then you will go under. Focus on the Lord and you will walk on water.

Please click on the REGISTRATION FOR MASSES link, then click on the date of the Mass that you wish to register for & fill in the details on the Google form, remember to click the Submit button. Please note, one registration for one individual only. eg. A family of eight fills in eight registration forms Once the quota at each mass has been reached Google forms will not accept more bookings. In that case you may try another mass time or venue. A register of attendees for contact tracing will be at the entrance. Please sign against your name and provide your contact details. This is a legal requirement. Enjoy Mass. Remember, Communion in the hand only, not on the tongue. Let us pray for one another & our world.




