Migrant and Refugee food drive ...

Migrant and Refugee Sunday provides an opportunity to raise awareness of the approximately 16,000 children and young people seeking asylum in Australia, who have been directly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, many of whom have no access to social security or Medicare.

In response, the St Vincent de Paul Society NSW partnered with Jesuit Refugee Service Australia as part of the No Child Left Behind campaign. From the 6-12 September 2020, we invited schools across New South Wales to raise awareness and take action in a National Week of Solidarity.

As part of Richmond Parish involvement we will now reinstate our food drive throughout October to support refugees and people seeking asylum. Biscuits, muesli bars, oats, cereal, tinned tomatoes, larger sizes of nappies, toothpaste & toothbrushes can be left in the baskets provided in the Church foyer over the coming weeks.

The NSW Government announced from July 1, the new rules keeping the state COVID-Safe mean: The number of people allowed inside indoor venues will be determined by the 'one person per 4 square metre rule, with no upper limit. Due to the one person per 4 square metre rule there will be no change at St Gregory's (28 people only) and Mass times are as follows at St Gregory's: Saturday 9am. Sunday 8am & 9am. From Friday 24th July, St Monica's Richmond are under strict guidelines set out by the NSW Government will be able to welcome 100 people at each mass. Mass times are as follows at St Monica's: Saturday Vigil 6.00pm. Sunday 7.30am, 9.30am & 5.30pm. To attend mass at St Monica's Richmond for weekday's no booking is needed. To participate at WEEKEND MASSES, online registration will still be required, this can be done through our Facebook page https://www.facebook.com/ParishofRichmondNSW/ or via the parish website https://parishofrichmond.org.au/. Please click on the REGISTRATION FOR MASSES link, then click on the date of the Mass that you wish to register for & fill in the details on the Google form, remember to click the Submit button. Please note, one registration for one individual only. eg. A family of eight fills in eight registration forms Once the quota at each mass has been reached Google forms will not accept more bookings. In that case you may try another mass time or venue. A register of attendees for contact tracing will be at the entrance. Please sign against your name and provide your contact details. This is a legal requirement. Enjoy Mass. Remember, Communion in the hand only, not on the tongue. Let us pray for one another & our world.


Email scam: Please be aware when opening emails supposedly from the Priests or the Parish, only open if they have the address shown on the parish bulletin & website.
