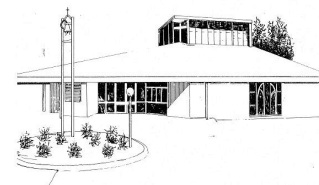

## The Most Holy Trinity — Year B 30 May 2021

### ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

### FIRST READING: DEUTERONOMY 4:32-34, 39-40

*The Lord himself is God in heaven above and on earth below: there is no other.*

### RESPONSORIAL PS: PSALM 34:4-6, 9, 18-20, 22

Happy the people the Lord has chosen to be his own.

### SECOND READING: ROMANS 8:14-17

*You have received the Spirit that makes you God's own children, and in that Spirit we call God: Father, our Father!*

### GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

**Alleluia, alleluia! Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: to God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!**

### GOSPEL: MATTHEW 28:16-20

*Baptise them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*

### COMMUNION ANTIPHON:

Since you are children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: **Abba, Father.**

### REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

O Great Spirit, whose voice I hear in the winds and whose breath gives life to the world, hear me. I come to you as one of your many children. I am small and weak: I need your strength and your wisdom. Make my eyes ever behold the red and purple sunset. Make my hands respect the things you have made, and my ears sharp to your voice. Make me wise so that I may know the things you have taught your children, the lessons you have hidden in every leaf and rock. Make me strong, so that I may not be superior to other people, but able to fight my greatest enemy, which is myself. Make me ever ready to come to you with straight eyes, so that when life fades as the fading sunset, my spirit may come to you without shame.

## Reflection on the Gospel - Trinity Sunday...

*"The feast of the Most Holy Trinity may well be regarded as the Church's Te Deum of gratitude over all the blessings of the Christmas and Easter seasons; for this mystery is a synthesis of Christmas, Epiphany, Easter, Ascension and Pentecost. This feast, which falls on the first Sunday after Pentecost, should make us mindful that actually every Sunday is devoted to the honor of the Most Holy Trinity, that every Sunday is sanctified and consecrated to the triune God. Sunday after Sunday we should recall in a spirit of gratitude the gifts which the Blessed Trinity is bestowing upon us. The Father created and predestined us; on the first day of the week He began the work of creation. The Son redeemed us; Sunday is the 'Day of the Lord', the day of His resurrection. The Holy Spirit sanctified us, made us His temple; on Sunday the Holy Spirit descended upon the infant Church. Sunday, therefore, is the day of the Most Holy Trinity."*

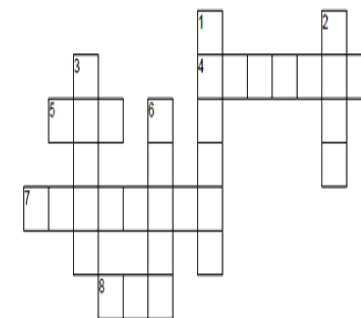

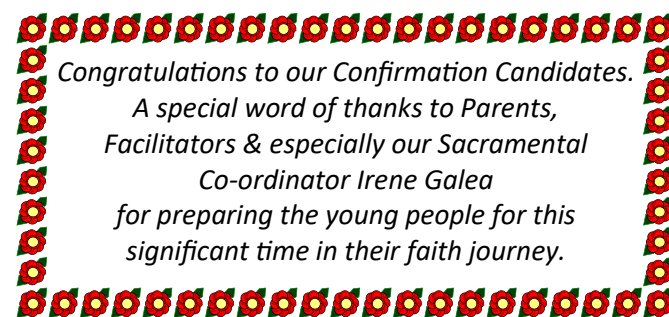
