

The Mandatory Safeguarding Modules...

Our Church and Parish life exists within the wider community. This means that those staff and volunteers who minister within parishes also have a very real role and responsibility in meeting the challenges and expectations given to us by government and legislation. One example that we have been used to for many years is the 'Working With Children Check'. The Diocese of Parramatta's Safeguarding Training has been designed in response to the Children's Guardian Act (2019) which was expanded to include religious organisations and volunteer workers. Safeguarding Training will help staff and volunteers understand their role and responsibility in ensuring the dignity and safety of all people is upheld.

The Training will help parishioners:

- build knowledge of Safeguarding Principles,
- develop skills in ensuring Child Safe Standards are embedded within our ministries, and
- support understanding of how to recognise and respond to incidents of 'reportable conduct'.

Safeguarding Mandatory Training. The Diocese requires that ALL members of ministries complete Safeguarding modules, online or via zoom. The Safeguarding Office has scheduled a series of dates for zoom training of the Mandatory Modules. The Zoom dates for Modules 1-3 are listed below:

- Tuesday 12 October Module 1: Introduction to Safeguarding 9.30am to 10.30am
- Tuesday 19 October Module 2: Understanding Child Abuse & Reportable Conduct 9.30am to 11.00am
- Tuesday 26 October Module 3: Safeguarding Adults at Risk 9.30am to 11.00am
