

A message from Bishop Vincent regarding the NSW Euthanasia Bill ...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2021 (NSW), will begin to be debated in NSW Parliament as early as 12 November 2021. We know how much laws that authorise the killing of patients by their doctors, or sanction the assistance of patient suicides undermine the dignity of the human person and put the vulnerable at risk. The Archdiocese of Sydney has led a campaign against the Bill, which we in the Diocese of Parramatta fully support. Given the vote in the Legislative Assembly of the NSW Parliament will be very tight, every parliamentarian's vote will make a difference.

Two MPs who have not declared how they will vote are based in the Diocese of Parramatta.

I ask parishioners to let them know our concerns about the Bill.

If there are any doctors, nurses or other medical professionals or lawyers who would be willing to speak with their MPs, please invite them to do so. We also know that MPs listen to the views of their electorates and so it is vital the Catholic community in these electorates are encouraged to phone their local member and express their concerns about the Bill.
