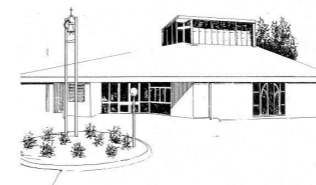

We are taking donations for the White Elephant Stall only & no later than Thursday 23rd June.

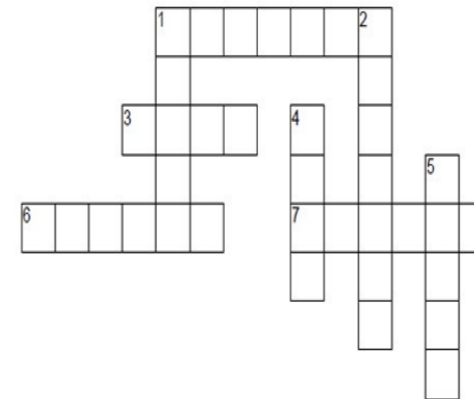
