

landscape after a rainfall. Fear can't produce a conversion of heart; only an encounter with love can. Zaccheus' conversion was a conversion to goodness. All of us stand in daily need of such a conversion. We need to move from a closed heart to an open heart, from a heart of stone to a heart of flesh.
