REFLECTIONS ON THE READING...

Understandably, we tend to zero in on the Eucharistic dimension of this Gospel. Yet, there are other aspects also to consider. Jesus comes as the stranger. He interprets and opens the Scriptures. We could wonder if the disciples would have recognized him otherwise. This passage is popular because it invites us to enter the world of metaphor. A visitor, a story, bread, wine, a lighted candle, all these and more tell us that the ordinary stuff of our lives is not so ordinary. Beyond function and practicality, the journey to Emmaus suggests the sacramentality of our lives.
