# Commissioning of Ministers ..

Our Catholic Parish of Richmond is alive and active. Look around at the strong witness shown by many parishioners who assist with the fifty plus parish ministries. They contribute through our liturgies & with liturgical support; music & evangelisation; community building & outreach; hospitality; fundraising; parish administration & maintenance; church cleaning & other behind the scenes activity. Why do people volunteer their services so generously & with commitment? It's because Grounded in the Sacraments of Initiation, lay people continue to be called to exercise their proper part in the mission and ministry of Christ, each in their own way, according to their own gifts. (Lumen Gentium 12, 31) Each year we are given the opportunity to re-commit ourselves to ministry. In recent years we have done this at the parish Masses on Pentecost Sunday. This year because the Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated within our Parish over 2 weekends, including Pentecost, all ministers will be commissioned by Fr Gayan or Fr Thomas at one of the parish Masses on the weekend of May 20/21.


