

Integral Ecology in Laudato Si' ...

Integral ecology is a key concept in Laudato Si'. It refers to the interconnectedness of all living things and recognizes that the environment, human society, and the economy are all interconnected. Integral ecology is based on the principle that everything is interconnected and that our actions have an impact on the environment.

The encyclical emphasizes that integral ecology must be based on a holistic and integrated view of the world. It must consider the interconnectedness of all living things and the impact of our actions on the environment. Integral ecology must also be guided by principles of social justice that promote the common good and protect the most vulnerable members of society. The role of integral ecology in Laudato Si' is to provide us with a framework for addressing environmental challenges that recognizes the interrelated nature of the environment, society, and the economy. It helps us to understand that environmental issues are not isolated problems, but are instead part of a larger system that requires integrated solutions.

Integral ecology also emphasizes the importance of addressing environmental issues in a way that promotes the common good and protects the most vulnerable members of society. This means considering the social, economic, and cultural factors that influence environmental issues and developing solutions that are just and equitable.




