Synods are transformative events that lead to renewal in the Church's life. Our Diocesan Synod will be held from 12-15 October 2023. Our Synod will gather clergy, religious, and the laity across our Diocese to listen, discern, and respond to the Holy Spirit through voices of the People of God in Western Sydney and The Blue Mountains.

Sustainable Development in Laudato Si' ...

Laudato Si' emphasizes the importance of sustainable development in addressing environmental challenges. Sustainable development is defined as development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

The encyclical recognizes that sustainable development requires a holistic and integrated approach that considers the social, economic, and environmental dimensions of development. It emphasizes the importance of promoting sustainable production and consumption patterns, reducing waste and pollution, and protecting biodiversity. The role of sustainable development in Laudato Si' is to provide us with a framework for addressing environmental challenges that promotes economic growth, social equity, and environmental protection. It recognizes that economic

development is essential for improving the quality of life for people around the world, but it must be done in a way that is sustainable and respects the limits of the environment.



White Damask table cloths: Were you kind enough to take the cloths to wash them following the Multicultural Dinner? They are used regularly for functions. Thank you.



MEMORIAL GARDEN PLAQUES:


If interested in having a loved one remembered in the Parish Memorial Garden please print on an envelope, the name of the person/s, also the name & phone number of the person placing the order.
