It provides us with a framework for addressing these challenges that is based on a holistic and integrated view

The encyclical emphasizes the importance of interdisciplinary approaches that bring together science, ethics, and social justice to address environmental issues. Laudato Si' also recognizes the importance of faith in inspiring and guiding us in our efforts to care for the environment.

It emphasizes the role of environmental ethics, integral ecology, sustainable development, ecological conversion, and global solidarity in addressing environmental challenges.






