ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Gospel Reflection ...

Jesus personally places all prayer that is prayed in his name before God the Father. Jesus is our direct prayer line to God. Being seated at the right hand of God, Jesus will judge the living and the dead. Jesus, God made human, is the one to

whom the Father has given this power, the one who knows intimately what it is like to be a human being. God has given this responsibility to the Son because of his Son's compassion and wisdom and his sacrificial death on the cross,

and it is Jesus who will call us to accountability for our lives.

Mark also gives us an account of Jesus's commissioning of the disciples just before he ascends. Jesus implores the disciples to go out now into the world, to go to the ends of the world, to preach his Gospel. This commissioning also applies to all today who proclaim themselves disciples of Jesus through their Baptism. We do not have to do this alone; Jesus himself will be our companion in the venture of sharing his Gospel.


Prayer for Christian Unity ...
