Dear one and all,

Currently designated as a Parochial District overseen by Deacon Tony, I've been appointed as the Founding Parish Priest of Marsden Park, which means I'll be leaving Richmond by the end of June 2024. The Bishop will appoint a new parish priest for Richmond Parish. Marsden Park is ready for a full-time parish priest, although it doesn't yet have a church building. The community currently gathers for Mass at St Luke's Catholic College, which hopes to secure a demountable building until a new church is built.

My appointment in Marsden Park officially begins in January 2025. Before moving, I plan to take a sabbatical during which I will serve as a full-time RAAF Chaplain for three months, followed by some personal leave. I initially intended to take my sabbatical after completing 20 years as a priest, but this wasn't possible due to my move to Richmond Parish. Therefore, I've decided to take the leave now, before transferring to Marsden Park, as I prefer not to start there and then take time off.

My time in Richmond has been both challenging and rewarding, and I wanted to share this news with you. Please keep me in your prayers as I transition to this new role in Marsden Park.


Diocesan Security Protocols Fr Peter Williams, Vicar General, has notified all Parishes of new Security Protocols that are effective immediately. All medical emergencies, suspicious activity, theft etc. are to be reported immediately to the Parish Priest or Parish Administration who then must notify the Diocese & relevant authorities. Fr Peter concludes: 'It is regrettable that we must make provision for such events, but the fragile nature of our world at present & increasing awareness of a lack of social cohesion requires that we are proactive in providing security for our clergy & people.'
