



### HONORING OUR GRANDPARENTS ..

The fourth commandment tells us to "honour your father and mother, so that your life/days may be long in the land which the lord your God gives you" (Exo 20:12). This also requires us to respect those people in authority: our teachers, governors, employers, and elders in general. Thus, our grandparents and senior citizens are also included among the elders and parents who deserve to be treated with honour, affection, and gratitude.

While Ephesians 6: 1-3, tells us to: "obey our parents/grandparents in the lord because that is the right thing to do"; the Catechism of the Catholic Church number 2197 reminds us that: "God has willed that, after him, we should honour our parent/grandparents to whom we owe life and who have handed on to us the knowledge of God". There are stories and news of "elders and grandparents abuses," where grandparents are abandoned in their homes or retirement facilities without visits, calls, or attention because everyone is busy with his/her own family and work pressure.

Although, article 2200 of the catechism of the catholic church reminds us that honouring and respecting our parents/grandparents "provides along with it: spiritual fruits, temporal fruits of peace, and prosperity". This article 2200 also wants us to understand that "failure" to honour, care, or respect our parents/grandparents, "brings great harm to communities and to individuals"

Friends, let us not forget that the joy of our grandparents will be complete if they can notice and feel that we their family members and friends are being loving, helpful, and giving generously towards improving their well-being and ensuring their happiness. May Sts, Joachim and Anne the grandparents of Jesus and the parents of Mother Mary, help us to be honour and care for our grandparents.

**Attention all those with “green thumbs”!**


