Saint Monica

This week, we honour Saint Monica, the mother of one of the greatest saints in the history of the Church: Saint Augustine. Born in Algiers in 331 A.D., Monica was raised in a Christian home but was given in marriage to a pagan named Patrick. Her married life was challenging due to Patrick's violent temper, infidelity, and his refusal to baptise their children.Despite these difficulties, Monica's deep faith and unwavering prayer life drove her to fervently pray for her family's conversion. Her persistent prayers were answered a year before Patrick's death in 370 A.D., when both he and his mother were converted and baptised.

Monica's trials extended to her son, Augustine, who, at age 19 while studying in Carthage, joined the heretical Manichean sect. In her distress, Monica initially expelled him from their home but was later reconciled with him after receiving a vision that assured her he would return to the faith. For seventeen years, Monica prayed and fasted for Augustine's return, following him to Rome and then Milan.In 387 A.D., under the guidance of Saint Ambrose, Augustine reconciled his intellectual struggles with his faith, converted to Christianity and received baptism. Augustine's book, *Confessions*, recounts the profound influence his mother had on his spiritual journey.

Saint Monica's life was marked by hardship and sorrow, yet she remained steadfast in her devotion to prayer and virtuous living. She is revered as a model of patience and hope, especially for those who have loved ones who have strayed from the faith.


