RETREAT: MY HOLIDAY SOUL SEARCHING TIME ..

Hello Everyone,

Holiday for busy people is an extended but very precious period of leisure, rest, and recreation, which is spent away from that which makes you busy for the purpose of being with family, friends, and/or for travelling. However, my annual retreat stole the show for my holiday this year. This is because in this special betwixt and between my being a diocesan priest or remaining a religious priest, I decided to have this year's retreat with the Spiritans (the group I intend to leave) in Nigeria.

The retreat was a soul-searching moment for me which was aimed at helping me to tell my vocation story by myself, bond for the first time in 20 years with the Spiritans of the Southeastern part of Nigeria in prayer, Eucharist, reflection, and social fraternity. It was also a separation catch-up with my fellow Spiritans, and it really achieved the purpose I designed for it. The retreat also reconnected me with my religious missionary root, opened my eyes and ears to the day-to-day plight of the priests and people in Nigeria, the problems and challenges of community life, the difficulties of some individual priests, and it also added more reasons to strengthen the big vocation decision I am about to make.

As Jesus asked his disciples "who do you say I am" (Matt 8:27-28), He wants us to set aside a soul-searching moment of personal retreat to reflect and to recognise how important Jesus' identity is for our faith. Let us grow closer to Christ and strengthen our commitment to following Him through this good Christian practice of soul-searching RETREATS.


