MY CREATION SPIRITUALITY

Hello Everyone,

In the delicate web of life, the need to satisfy man's greed, economic development, industrialization, need for housing, etc., create some ecological challenges for humanity. This accounts for why Pope Francis' encyclical on "caring for our common home", invited every person on earth, to reflect on how we are shaping the future of our planet through humans' daily actions and decisions.

Since 1st September 2024, till the end of the season of creation month on 4th October 2024, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi – patron of ecology; we were invited to examine our own creation spirituality to see if: we listen through deep communion with nature, and if we contribute our own creative power in God's continuing process of creation in the universe.

This just concluded season of creation month gave us opportunity to renew our relationship with God as creator, and creation, through prayers for the care of creation, and actions for our common home. However, for us Catholics, creation tells us more about God's nature, his omnipotence, and his transcendence. Genesis 1: 27-28 reminds us that: "God created mankind in his own image and likeness; male and female he created them, and he gave them power to rule over all other creatures, and to take care of the earth.
