Rich in Graciousness

This week, in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus unpacks the answer to the question: how to enter eternal life. Jesus answers, in summary, that the key is to trust God, rather than 'riches'.

The young man who asked this guestion in the gospel was clearly certain that his money was 'trustworthy'. Jesus corrected, "Go, sell everything you own..., and then come, follow me." This is another way of instructing to 'remove your alternative objects of trust and put God back at the heart.'

This was not a judgment on the rich from Jesus, but a warning regarding the peculiar struggles awaiting those who rely on riches. Trusting in worldly resources and being a disciple of Christ do not mix well. Money does not take away spiritual progress; however it makes the process slower and sluggish. So, is it possible to enter the kingdom while being rich? The answer is "yes."

How? There is only one way to be rich and good at the same time: by being rich in gracious deeds. The same chapter 6 from Timothy, which called money 'the source of evil', will also say, "Do not trust in riches, but be rich in good deeds." Don't accumulate. Always find ways to divert and give away your riches to those in need. Acknowledge that God is the giver of everything good, and we are merely stewards. Invite God back to the heart of our lives, and adopt God's concern for the poor as our ongoing concern, and way to become rich in graciousness.


