Hello Everyone,

Attending the Diocesan Gathering and contributing to the launch of our 2024-2028 Pastoral Plan for a Synodal Church on behalf of the Parish of Richmond, alongside Mary and Bernie, was something I really enjoyed. The day consisted of two plenary sessions and two workshops. A special highlight between these sessions was the opportunity to connect with other parishes in our diocese, especially those involved in youth ministry, who are doing great work and can inspire us at Luke 24 Youth Ministry.

If I could summarise my experience and learnings from the Diocesan Gathering into two key points, they would be these:

**The concept of Synodality:** One of the speakers said, "A synodal church is a church which listens, and listening is more than just hearing. Synodality is how the people of God relate to each other and engage with the world." This resonated with me because it's something I see reflected so much in the Parish of Richmond, where active listening is truly practiced.

**We are a volunteer church:** Every member of the church is vital for its success, but we can only be a Christ-centred church because the Holy Spirit guides us. Everything we do is under the Holy Spirit's guidance, which is evident in the dedication of our volunteers across various ministries.

The Bible verse highlighted in the Pastoral Plan is "Behold, I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20). As we move forward with embracing the Pastoral Plan, may our faith and the Holy Spirit guide us, just as Jesus led his disciples in their journey of faith.




