Thus, we can direct our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming and to the anniversary of His birth on Christmas.

In conclusion brethren, how can you be more watchful and vigilant in your daily life this season? During this advent, how can you better prepare your heart for the coming of Jesus for your spiritual growth? Let us seek God's guidance so that we shall prepare our hearts for the coming of Jesus by being more faithful, watchful, prayerful, and holy in words, deeds, and actions.






