# THE JOY OF BEING RECONCILLED WITH GOD AND NEIGHBOUR

Hello Everyone,

In the sacrament of reconciliation, penance, or confession, Catholics go to admit their personal sins to a priest, and thus, receive sacramental pardon and peace upon expressing contrition for their sins. This sacrament helps us to grow in holiness and virtue; and it imparts on us sinners the mercy, love and forgiveness of God who reconciles us with Himself and one another.

On Wednesday, this week at 7pm, we shall have our communal liturgical celebration of the second rite of the sacrament of penance; wherein we listen to the word of God, examine our conscience, reflect together on where and how we have fallen short of our baptismal commitment to follow Christ, and then make our individual confession of sins according to their kind and number, and so receive absolution after. Those going to confession can limit the time they spend with the confessor since it is not the first rite in which more time for integral confession and spiritual guidance is available.

As we joyfully celebrate this third Sunday of Advent in which we are called to rejoice, repent, and be converted because the Lord is near; let us humble ourselves through this sacrament by approaching a confessor for God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us find joy and hope in the coming of the Lord, so that we shall know the fullness of God's grace and mercy. Let us in thanksgiving, praise and bless the presence of the Lord who reconciles us with Himself and one another; so that we can find joy and peace in His love, and so prepare our hearts for Jesus' coming.
