JUBILEE 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE

A Jubilee Year is a sacred time of prayer, pilgrimage, and conversion. The Roman Catholic Church dedicates every twenty-five years as a JUBILEE YEAR of prayer to re-establish a proper relationship with God, humanity and creation. Thus, on 24th December 2024, the eve of Christmas in Rome, Pope Francis opened the Jubilee Year 2025, with the opening of the HOLY DOOR in St. Peter's Basilica. This will go on till the 6th of January 2026.

He also designated three places: The Franciscan Shrine of the Holy Innocents, Kellyville; St Patrick's Cathedral, Parramatta; and Mount Schoenstatt Shrine, Mulgoa, as Pilgrimage sites in our diocese.

As we personally say our jubilee prayer, go for confessions, and undergo some pilgrimages to the designated sites, may we gain the full plenary indulgence granted for active participation of Pilgrims in the course of this Holy Year. May the Baptism of our Lord which we celebrate today help us to continue to "Fan the flame of Hope that has been given to us, and to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart, and far-sighted vision" as Pope Francis prayed. And may we never be disappointed as we Journey in Hope.


You may also Purchase St Vincent De Paul clothing vouchers which the inmates can trade in for clothing.
