Hello Everyone,

Some cultures of the world hold that "promises are meant to be broken". But could this be true? Or is it their simple way of explaining or trying to understand why humans make promises but fail to keep them or choose to break them. Jesus in Matthew 5:37 said: "But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'. For whatever is more than these is from the evil one". St. James also said: "...my brothers, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or by any other oath, but let your 'yes' be yes and your 'no' be no" (James 5:12). 
