THE PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL IS CALLING YOU

Hello Everyone,

One of the basic canonical groups to be formed or found in every parish is the Parish Pastoral Council. It is a group of elected or appointed parishioners whose special responsibility involves investigating all those things which pertain to the pastoral works, pondering over them, and recommending or offering appropriate advice and practical solutions for the Parish Priest's consideration. They collaborate with him to achieve the vision and mission of the church in relation to other pastoral needs and problems of the faith community, which promotes the growth, holiness and vibrancy of the parish.

Being elected or appointed as a member of the Parish Pastoral Council gives one the opportunity to serve the parishioners for three years, to work for God, and to support our parish and priests. This opportunity is challenging and encouraging too, but it will be a kind of disservice to self or the parish, if we let this opportunity of nominating an effective representative of our choice pass us by. Members of the PPC meet on the second Wednesday of the month or every other month as agreed. They collaborate with our bishop and priests on promoting our diocesan and parochial Strategic Pastoral Plan and various projects. They also support the Parish Priests and Coordinator of Ministries to care for the numerous parish ministry groups, and to plan and organize events and activities like: Parish Multicultural Dinner, Feast Day, Volunteers' BBQ, Parish Retreats, Parish Outing, and responding to issues when needed.

Let us pray for the ability to select men and women who will be courageous enough to share their time, talent, and resources in faithful and humble service that binds, renews, and enriches our parish community. Lastly, let us not harden our hearts or feel unconcerned in this process which lasts from February to March 2025, because we are the 'hands and feet' of Jesus in our parish, and our vote counts.

ADULT SERVERS are to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church, can be male or female, <u>eighteen years old or</u> <u>older</u>. Adult Servers are appointed by the Parish Priest. The Adult Servers take part in the procession to & from the sanctuary & assist in areas allocated to them. They assist the Minister of the Altar & the Priest.

SENIOR SERVERS are those who <u>have been</u> /<u>are serving</u> as Junior Servers for at least four years. They are to guide & help the Junior Servers to know, understand & execute their role as Junior Servers.

JUNIOR SERVERS are to be baptised Catholics, received their first Holy Communion, male or female. They help with the smooth flow of the liturgy. They enable the priest and the congregation to celebrate the Eucharist in a worthy manner.
