THE VALUE OF FORGIVENESS

When I say: "forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us", I am simply confessing my faith, sinfulness, and repentance before God whom I expect to forgive me and others around me of our sins, because I am also ready to forgive them of their sins against me. This shows that "forgiveness" is of great importance because it reflects God's love and grace for humanity. Hence, asking for forgiveness, and being forgiven by God and neighbour, becomes an essential spiritual exercise that heals and restores our relationship with God and neighbour.

This valuable spiritual exercise reminds us of our traditional church principle which encourages us to confess our sins and receive Holy Communion at least once a year, especially during the season of Easter (canon 920). This church guideline is called Easter Duty. Thus, many parishes provide their members the opportunity of confessing their sins during this special season to prepare them spiritually to participate fully in the events of the Paschal Mystery of the Lord which include: the passion, death, resurrection and ascension into glory.

Dear friends, we cannot underestimate the value and benefits of forgiveness because they are boundless. Besides restoring our friendship with God and others, forgiving others and receiving forgiveness helps us to: grow spiritually and to demonstrate God's love and compassion. It brings us peace of mind, emotional healing, and psychological freedom because of the knowledge that we have been reconciled with God and neighbour. As Jesus today in the gospel from John 8: 1-11 reminds us of the importance of forgiveness when he said: "let the person without sin be the first to throw a stone"; let us then prepare ourselves to actively participate in **the second rite of reconciliation to be held here on Tuesday 8th of April 2025 at 7 pm in St. Monica's Richmond.**

If interested in having a loved one remembered in the Parish Memorial Garden please print on an envelope, the name of the person/s, also the name & phone number of the person placing the order.


