A MOTHER'S UNCONDITIONAL LOVE

Sometimes, we choose to change our job, friends, location, car, residential address, etc. but we cannot replace our biological mothers with another mother - no matter how important that other woman may be in your life. In the bible, Mary, Mother of Jesus, proverbs 31, Isaiah 66:13, and Psalm 139: 13-14, give us good examples of how a virtuous mother's skills, unconditional love, and care for her child and family, can guide and influence her child's spiritual life. Hence, each mother's love for her child is unique and incomparable, even though the heart of motherhood may be the same.

Last Sunday, we celebrated our mothers and those who play the mother figure roles in our lives. It was an occasion that invited us to remember in a special way the maternal bonds and love we have shared with our mothers (whether dead or alive), and to appreciate the influence of mothers in shaping the world. This encourages us to continue to praise God for the gift of our mothers and motherhood in general because we were fearfully and wonderfully made inside our mothers' wombs (Jeremiah 1:5a).

As we continue to thank God for the gift of our mothers, may we be prepared to reciprocate their unconditional love for us which is fashioned in the image of God's love because it complies with Jesus' new commandment for us to love one another (John 13: 34-35). This type of love often requires sacrifice and putting others' needs before our own just as every good mother does. Jesus reminds us that Love is not just an emotion but a choice we make which is backed up by acts of: kindness, forgiveness, patience, and wanting the best for others, just as Jesus loved us. Let us show that we are true disciples of Christ in the world by the way we treat others.
