REST, LISTEN, and LOVE.

Pope Leo this week has returned from his time at Castle Gandolfo, where he spent 16 days of rest. It's not that the Pope has been on vacation, but rather something more akin to a spiritual retreat. He stepped into a place of quiet, a time of reflection and discernment about the calling of the Holy Spirit. This time of prayer and reflection comes at a particularly important moment in his papacy – at the beginning – and stands as a reminder that we too, need to find rest in our lives, *especially* when we're about to undertake a big endeavour.

Pope Leo, in his Sunday homily, spoke about the importance of silence. He said that rest is more than just stepping away from work. To truly rest means to step away from noise and distractions. The goal is to make time sacred again, and to better help us to hear the voice of God. We've all heard that saying before, "I need another holiday after that vacation!" How we choose to spend our time in rest is important. Without proper rest, we do ourselves a disservice, and our relationships with God and other's will suffer.

As Pope Leo comes back from a bit of rest in the beautiful gardens of Castle Gandolfo, he reminds us all that sometimes, the most powerful thing we can do is to simply pause—rest, listen, and love. I wish you all a very happy and restful week ahead,


