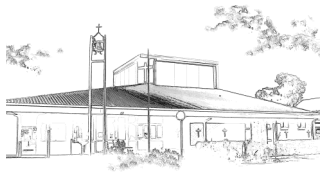

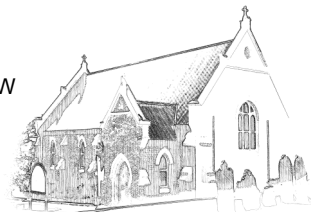

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Acts 1:11

Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

ASCENSION OF CHRIST: A NEW KIND OF PRESENCE

The Ascension of Christ reminds us of the return of Jesus' risen and glorified body into heaven in the face of his disciples who stood perplexed and overwhelmed, as they attempted to say their good-bye to Him, while imagining how their lives and mission would be in the absence of Jesus. This is an experience that most of us who have lost a dependable loved one can relate with. How in our confusion and sadness we wished that a miracle could happen as we still enjoyed the last glimpse of the person for him/her to wake up from sleeping in death.

The Apostles of Jesus while gazing at the sky, were also wishing that Jesus would not leave them to exist in corporeal form with God the father beyond the conventional physical world, so that they would not feel his absence greatly. Thinking like this, shows that the disciples failed to understand that Christ's ascension was ushering in "a new kind of presence" and new life for believers. Thus, believers are commissioned to go into the whole world and preach the good news of repentance and forgiveness of sins in the name of Jesus to all nations (Luke 24: 46-47).

My dear brothers and sisters, the Ascension of Christ together with the promise of the Holy Spirit, empowers us to actively assume Jesus' mission of saving humanity by "touching hearts, teaching minds, and transforming lives". It challenges us to be like Jesus, and to do what Jesus did by perpetuating his memory and continuing His legacy. Are we prepared to hold onto one another as we live in hope for the glorious coming of our lord? Are we also willing to do as Jesus did, or to be the visible presence of Jesus in the society through giving ourselves over to the Spirit of God who heals and gives life to those in need of our help and presence? Happy Ascension of the Lord!
